This is just a short update of the last month or so showing what God has been doing in our lives in completing this Great commission in getting the boat “Qaamaneq” to Greenland, to continue our calling of take the Gospel to the northern Greenlandic people (Inuit) and teaching them the Word of God.

Our Friends in Greenland:

We keep in contact via Skype and email with our friends in Greenland and their excitement is growing as the date for the crossing nears. We leave in about 3 weeks (July 13th) and all is on schedule, His schedule.

As we Skype our friends there in Greenland, we receive prayer requests from them and we pray with them on Skype. They are very excited for our return so we can teach them how to pray and answer the questions that are coming up as they read the Word. It’s encouraging for us to hear them talk about the up and coming plans in ministering to the people in our small town too. The Lord has kept them on fire for Him while we have been away for so long. There are plans for the youth, and well as the very young orphans we now have in town.

All this we do in the winter time because we can’t travel north with the boat until summer, and the ice melts for it to be clear for our summer ministry of teaching the villagers of northern Greenland. We plan to stay in a village for weeks and perhaps months, as the Lord leads, to ground the people in His Word, then keep in contact via phone or internet where possible. When seeds are planted, the seeds need watering. ***[1 Cor. 3:6-9](#) Teaching His Word***

The boat, “Qaamaneq”

It has taken nearly 2 years (about 10 month of working on the boat) for the preparation of the boat to be upgraded, repaired, and retrofitted for a life in Greenland as well as preparing it for a 2,000 mile, 2 week trip across the Atlantic Ocean for a ministry in Greenland.

I have done most of all the work on the boat myself, with some help and a lot of advice. ***[And with your prayers and support through mostly the body of Christ, we will be ready for our crossing this coming July 13th. The Lord uses the body of Christ to accomplish His will. So we thank the Lord and all for you that have been praying and supporting this long journey.](#)***

The Lord's hand has been guiding us all the way and the last need was installing an additional fuel tank below deck. We are sending a few pics to show the hard work that has taken place to make all this happen **for His Glory in reaching the unreachable.**

There are no roads from village to village or town to town, the only way from one village to another is by boat. And as we go north we needed a place to stay so we have to live on the boat. This is why the boat the lord gave us is the perfect boat.

It has 2 separate sleeping quarters, 2 bathrooms, one shower and a fairly large galley and sitting room for prayer and Bible studies. This is where Anda & Laila accepted Christ last year. The boat will be the home for 4 to 5 people for 1 to 3 months or as needed.

Our prayer needs haven't changed much, it has been all about the boat and the journey. But let's now add that the Lord will prepare ahead of us the path of salvation for many in northern Greenland as Qaamaneq goes forward doing His will. There are financial needs yet to make the crossing; Please see our website!
