Greetings from Daniel & Solveig,

Read the verses !!!

We apologize for the late update, when we first arrived with the boat here in Qasigiannuit, Greenland Solveig left to be with her mother a few days before she passed on, then stayed in the Faroe Island a while with family. Thank you for the emails of condolences for Solveig & I.

Our return to Greenland

Before we update you all on what the Lord has been doing & the ministry plans here in Greenland, we would like to share what has been happening day by day to make it so we can continue His work in Greenland.

Because of Solveig's obligations for citizenship in the USA and then God's plan for a boat in Greenland to be used as transportation and living as we travel further north, taking the gospel, it has been nearly 2 years since we left Greenland. To me the urgency is even greater than when we first arrived in Greenland in 2014 to share and teach His Word to the Greenlandic people. Time is short!!! [Luke 12:40](#)

So now legal paperwork needs to be done for my stay here as well as all the other paperwork needed for just everyday needs such as trash and poop pickup, electrical, water delivery, and the list goes on. The Lord has been helping us with all the red tape issues and we are now finally seeing the light at the end of the tunnel.

Then there is the boat!!! It's all new logistics for us as well as an ***enormous*** learning curve. Just trying to store the boat for the winter (when & where) took over a month to work out. Winter is here now and we have to act fast. "Qaamaneq" comes out of the water this week because our temperatures are around -7C and still dropping.

And this was a true God miracle!!! We wanted to store the boat here in town but there wasn't enough time to work out the details so we need to take the boat to another town west of us about 4 hrs @ 10 kts to a place called Aasiaat. To make it short, to remove the boat and store it for the winter months then put it back in the water was going to cost \$10,000 US dollars. But after a short talk with the owner of the boat yard he is only going to charge us labor for taking the boat out of the water and putting it back in, NO STORAGE FEES, which means about \$1000 US only, that's God and His grace. Thank You Lord!!!!

The Lord Working & Our Ministry Plans

When we arrive back in Qasigianguit, people were excited about this new big boat in town so we had an open house on board, inviting people on board for tea & coffee. To many it was a surprise to hear what the plan was for the boat and some showed interest in what we are planning. (Taking His Word to the northern people) We met possible prospects that may be of help going north for translation, and others that seem to be interested in learning more about this Jesus stuff.

We don't believe in planting foreign churches in a foreign land, we believe in Christ and repentance, training up a leader of that land, and letting the natives of the land teach their own. They can plant a church if they want or do home fellowships we just direct them with the Word. It's their people and their land I am just a beginning instructor, it's the Holy Spirit that does the work after being born again. [John 3:3](#)

We have had a few bible studies in the last few weeks totaling about 11 hours in time "rightly dividing the Word". [2Tim 2:15](#) it was a great time of study. Now that winter is setting in and the boat is out of the water we are planning to have weekly Bible Studies starting next week, Lord willing. Many have shown interest in coming, including the priest of the town from the Lutheran church. I have also written a letter to the church in town to apply for the empty board member seat, with hopes to help direct the church toward the truth and not tradition. We'll see if the Lord opens that door.

And now is the time to start planning our northern trip/s with the boat, looking at charts to plan a safe course, as well as planning a way to keep in contact through the winter months after leaving a village to continue the growth in Christ. We'll be writing up reading and study plans in Greenlandic, of which there is very little available. So Solveig with Greenlandic friends will be translating the materials from English to Greenlandic. Also we would like to continue in recording the Greenlandic Bible in CD or USB stick (Times are changing). We have finished 5 books so far in the New Testament, so there is a long way to go.

We thank you for your prayers and support; it's what keeps us going here in Greenland and increases the Kingdom of God. It's about souls and eternity.....We are workers for His Kingdom. [1 Cor. 9:19-27](#)
