Merry Christmas to everyone, we hope that your Christmas time will be a time of thankfulness in reflecting on the blessings the Lord has given us everyday & "Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!"

We have invited 1 couple and 3 other people to our home for Christmas dinner that don't have any family in town & otherwise would be alone for Christmas. That's 7 people in a 10ft by 14ft room which is our Kitchen, dining room and living room in one. Not sure how we'll do it yet but we'll get it worked out somehow.

The Ministry:

Bible studies are going well, most of the time it's a full house, we are packed in like sardines in a can. The home environment makes people feel more comfortable to ask questions and people have commented on the peace they get when they come to our house. If more people want to come maybe we'll start having Bible studies twice a week. The ministry the Lord entrusted to us is often a one on one ministry, and at least once a week we invite people over for dinner.

About 2 weeks back we invited a couple over for dinner that never really liked us because we follow the ways of Christ living for Jesus. Well this year the Lord broke through to them and we invited them over for dinner. So just before we began to eat I said rather quickly lets thank the Lord for our dinner and again I rather quickly bowed my head and began pray. My prayers are usually a little long for most people but I thought this time it was a little shorter than usually. When I finished I looked up and saw an unexpected expression of confusion. The wife said, wish you would have warned us, I didn't know what to do, then the husband says yeah, this is the first time we have ever seen someone pray for a meal, what were we supposed to do? They did think it was nice, though.

It opened the door for much conversation about who God is, where He came from and this guy called Jesus Christ and who is He. For the next few hours we talked about the Lord and the Bible and why we believe what we believe. But let me tell you something that they don't know yet! Their son of whom I have been witnessing to for the last few years went to Boston for English lessons/training & while there he began to attend a Baptist Church and even sang a solo on a Sunday morning I've been told. Keep this family in prayer! God is working! The young man is coming home for Christmas so I'll be talking to him soon.

The African Ministry we left:

In 2014 we left Uganda Africa by the word of the Lord in a prayer of obedience, hence the beginning of the Greenlandic ministry. So what is happening with our Ugandan Pastor friend, Fred Asimwe & GIOP church?

First GIOP means God Is Our Provider, a name Pastor Fred remembered from a dream he had. After 3 years of discipleship with Fred we filed for the first **non-denominational** church permit for Fred to start in Uganda. It had to go through the President personally for approval. He said yes after many letters of explanations of what it meant and why **non-denominational**.

In 2007 I left the U.S. for Uganda out of obedience of a calling, with a one way ticket and now Pastor Fred has over 20 GIOP church independent of each other, on the islands of Lake Victoria and the mainland, but all are one in the body of Christ. Fred pastors a church on Bugala Island & helps guide the others on how to function as an independent church, with Christ as the head.

We helped start a radio ministry called Walk Through the Word and it continues today, 5 days a week with Pastor Fred teaching and at times they play CDs with studies from a great friend of mine, Pastor David Hocking.

We talk to Pastor Fred about issues and different things every few weeks & sometimes more often. In the last 5 years he was almost murdered 3 different times, poisoned once, kidnapped, robbed & left for dead in an ally, just to mention a few issues he has had. **PASTOR FRED NEEDS PRAYER!!!**

We may not be there, but the mission continues.

The GIOP church has many people from all denominations coming together as one body. God is doing mighty works through Pastor Fred and His ministry. We thank our Lord Jesus Christ for His faithfulness in leading Fred & the Faithfulness of Pastor Fred in his perseverance to never quit, no matter what. Please, Please Pray for Fred.

We Thank you all again for the Prayers & Financial support this year of 2019 & 2018 as well. The Boat is now here expanding His ministry to the "Top of the World". It has been a blessing to partner with so many people that helped in so many ways, and to watch the Lord work it through. **Seeing many miracles along the way!!**

There were a few times where we were ready to throw in the towel & call it quits, it got so hard, some lost faith in us and maybe in Him, but His Word is TRUE !!!
