Greetings to you all,

Things are well here in Qasigiannuit, Greenland & at the time we are Covid-19 free. Since we are free to travel between villages, our northern trip to a village is on schedule. We're leaving this Tuesday July 7th for the north.

OUR FIRST TRIP NORTH

*There's much to plan and prepare for to make a self sustaining 3 week trip to northern Greenland in a boat and so much to try to remember to bring on the trip. This being our first trip north with the boat, there are many unknowns. There is food, water for drinking, water for showers, equipment and materials for teaching and preaching, tools for the boat, safety gear, guns for protection, and the list goes on. We trust the Lord will ensure we have all the bases covered. **Proverbs 3:5&6***

We have a crew of 4 people, which includes Solveig, Ed the person we spoke about in our last update, and another young man named Ian and myself. Both are young Greenlandic men in their early 20s and both very excited to serve the Lord in the way that we are. Also both eagerly volunteered and I think after much prayer we have a great team/crew. Neither of them knows much about boating so we have a good challenge ahead of us and I'm kind of new at all this as well, so keep us in prayer.

Last week we went south to Nuuk to buy microphones, a speaker, mixer, projector and other needed equipment for what we are doing.

If you recall from our last update, we are starting off with a short message then showing the movie "The Passion of the Christ". We are planning to stay in a village for several weeks to a month to ground new believers in Christ, and then staying in touch throughout the winter months (8 months) by email and phone to help them grow in Christ. We'll be leaving them with study materials to help them as they grow in Him.

We also had to buy a new ship to shore boat, since the one we bought in Canada was just too unsafe so we bought a zodiac type boat to replace it, it's what we needed to do; live and learn.

Word travels fast here in town, some mock, and some are happy we are doing what we are doing. Also we will be out of contact while we are away from our town. No emails or phone contact until we return home to Qasigiannuit. We will send an update upon our return.
