Greetings to you all,

If you recall from our last update, due to the baptism tub we put on the back of the boat and the belief of the Greenlandic people about baptism, we could feel the rejection of some here in town, Anda and Laila especially. Even so, we push forward in our calling and are reminded of ***Romans 11:29*** For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable. And also ***Romans 11:33*** O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! how unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out! He is still working no matter what and always does!!!! This last Thursday we had a full house in our Bible study, as well as a new person that has joined us.

MINISTRY WORK

But one of the most encouraging things that has happened this month was at the church board meeting; let me recap. We attend the local church board meetings in hopes that the Lord will work through us in reaching the town priest, and others, opening her eyes to the truth of His Word. They have been reading from a prayer book that is used regularly in their church services to open and close the meetings. In one way that was a move forward because the first board meeting we attended there was no prayer. But I asked the priest after the third board meeting why don’t we pray from our heart? Well, this last board meeting not only did we open with worship, something else we talked about, but the priest asked me to close in prayer!!!!!! God is still working, even though at times we feel like it’s just an uphill battle without gaining any ground. Thank you Lord!!!!

Prayer is what breaks the strongholds of evil so please pray, pray, pray to break that stronghold of sin that is so prevalent here in Greenland. On the surface this place looks like a beautiful haven, but break that surface and you see what is really there. Please pray, pray, pray that their eyes will be open to see the truth and repent from the wicked ways.

We also have started a kind of outreach inviting someone every week over for dinner, let me expand on that. Most Greenlandic people don’t wave or say hi, or acknowledge us or their own friends in any way, as they see them in town, but we say hi to almost everybody we walk past. So now we have decided to invite someone over for dinner that we just say hi to on the street once a week, in hopes to break the misconception that we find many have about us. We want to help them see who we really are and what we truly believe in. We have had a few dinners already and things really went well.

The Boat “Qaamaneq”

Remember we have damaged propellers and we need to take the boat out of the water to repair them and a few other things, but we are still waiting for a spot at the shipyard in Aasiaat. So the boat is still anchored in our bay. There are a few things I can do while anchored in our bay, but the major work that needs to be done I have to wait until the boat is on land. The propellers need to be removed and sent to England to be refurbished. We are not sure of the cost, but we hope it wouldn't be too much. Winter seems to be coming fast so the season with the boat this year is finished. I can't even go hunting!!!

I also have not been invited to go hunting this year yet, maybe because of the tub issue. Anda went hunting already and didn't invite me, but I hope somebody will ask me to go. I have asked a few people but they gave reasons why I couldn't go with them. We would like to get meat (Reindeer) for the freezer for the winter, it helps a lot in food cost. Pray for this to happen, although my feet & knees aren't doing well, so maybe that's why the Lord is closing that door.
