The clips show our everyday life and ministry work. Our work is 24/7 one on one mostly with counseling, which we don't film. Much of the encouraging and counseling happens over the phone and person to person any time day or night.

It's been a while since the last update, for that we are very sorry. Often, time goes so fast and with so much to keep track of I just lost track of time. All is well and we are very busy in several arenas. We're keeping a watch on Boat repairs, (more on that later in this update), still taking late evening phone calls lasting for over an hour, one on one counseling, Translations, Bible studies, dinners with different Greenlanders and more.

We have been invited over for dinner, to a person we invited for dinner a while back. This will be the second person inviting us since we started this dinner outreach and that's great. The dinners are always Christ centered and the Lord is working in several new hearts, praise God.

Also for the people that have been donating to our ministry work here in Greenland, we humbly apologize for the late tax exempt letter; you should be receiving it in a few days. It was a miscommunication on my part and we'll do better next time. We again thank you for the kind generosity that keeps this ministry and us going forward to reach the hard to reach people in northern Greenland with the Good News of the saving grace of salvation through Christ Jesus our Lord. **Philippians 4:17** Not that I seek the gift, but I seek the fruit that increases to your credit.

The Boat

The work on the boat is moving right along. The propellers have been repaired and reinstalled, the rudders are fixed and a few other small issues in the steering mechanism is finished....Praise God. There are just a few other little odds and ends to finish, and then she should be ready to go back in the water around the first week of May.

Baptism & Northern Trip

We are planning a baptism around the last week of June about 10 miles south of our town in a small lake. We're not sure how many people will be getting baptized yet, but at least 1 and we pray that the Lord will move a few more hearts to find Him and put their trust and faith in Jesus Christ. If you didn't know already, we only have a few roads in town, but no road any other places outside of any town/village in Greenland, so we will be taking our boat to the lake for the baptism. It's in a small bay, so I'm told.

The northern trip is planned for around July but the date is not yet set. This weekend we are making general plans. The village we will be traveling to is also still open but we will know in a few weeks. It has to be a safe protected bay so we can anchor safely.

Planning a trip in a boat this size takes a lot of good planning. We have meals to plan for 3 to 4 weeks, water, fuel, oil, watches to schedule, washing clothes, showers and the list goes on. We only have so much water so conservation is a must.

The northern trip will take about 36 to 48 hours, depending on the destination. We'll be driving 24/7, so you can see scheduling sleep is needed as well as cooking & eating in shifts. The boat will be our home for 4 people in that 3 to 4 weeks.

The crew is set now with me (Daniel) Solveig my wife, Eddie and Ian, the same crew as last year. There will be some changes from last year in many different areas of planning but we know this trip will be a much better outcome than last year. We learned a lot and we plan not to repeat the same mistakes twice.

But what is really wonderful with this trip is that the last trip Eddie and Ian were looking for an adventure, this year they both are going to serve the Lord and both are excited to see what the Lord is going to be doing. Both of them will be translating and giving their testimonies. The next update we'll be giving more details on how and what we will be doing for 3 to 4 weeks in the village that the Lord opens for us, for His glory. Amen
