Greetings from Greenland,

It's been around 2 ½ years since we have been back to the USA on a visit, Covid-19 being the main reason, but now the Lord has opened the door for a 3 month visit from Oct. 6 thru Dec.26th. It will be a very busy 3 months with Doctor & Dentist appointments, updating legal documents, presentations, meetings and more. Then there is family and friends. We hope to find some time to relax, maybe for a week somewhere, just Solveig and I, pray for that please.

PREPARING FOR OUR 3 MONTH JOURNEY AWAY:

One of the main hurdles was trying to find a place to dry-dock the boat. Our whole trip was booked last month then our arrangements for dry-dock got canceled.

This was a major crisis, to say the least. The boat cannot stay in the water during winter because the ocean freezes, and that's not good for the boat. Anyway, the Lord gave us a BIG faith builder, of which we didn't handle too well, I hate to say and for over a month there was no solution. The issue was not solved until just last week and we could not have left Greenland without a resolution. We're glad that issue is over.

Then there's the house that needs to be prepared for the winter without us here. We need to fill up the heating oil tank, set the heater so pipes don't freeze, sign out at the government office, and the list goes on.



Winter has arrived and it has been snowing for days off and on now, so it looks like summer is gone. The bay has not iced over yet so we leave here in less than a week to go to an airport town by boat taxi, but as for our return in December, we will fly into our town by helicopter.

MINISTRY UPDATE: (THE PEOPLE)

If you're new to our updates, or just can't remember so far back, in the last few years three young people gave their lives to Christ, Ian, Eddie & Juliana.

Eddie is attending the Greenland University (Not like our Universities), in Nuuk, about 500 miles south of us and he seems to be a prayer warrior. Doing well in school sharing Christ, working at the store and studying the Word of God, Eddie has come a very long way in his walk of repentance and over all life. They said (The Government) that Eddie is mentally challenged and he has had many other very hard issues in his life to overcome. (**1 John 5:4** Overcomes) Through Christ, Eddie conquered it all and is becoming a strong man of God.

Ian the young man we baptized this summer is walking strong in Christ also and witnessing to his fellow students and family. He is attending school in Aasiaat where the boat is in dry-dock for the winter. He too has come a very long way in his life accomplishing things that people thought he could never do, again, all through the power of the Lord Jesus Christ (**Philippians 4:13**).

A few months ago Ian's father, Kunuut, borrowed my Bible just to read something while ferrying his boat from Denmark to Greenland and he still has my Bible.



Yesterday I talked to Kunuut, Ian's father, on the phone and we talked about the Bible for about 30 minutes. Then near the end of our conversation he says, *"Well if there is a God and I do good He will take me into heaven"*. I said to him, what is good & what is bad, does your good outweigh your bad, and how do you know all this, Also I said the Bible is ALL true and it is God's message to us, believe it all or not at all and live your life the way you want. So if you don't believe the Bible, you can give it back to me.....he said "NO", I asked him, "why not", he said, "because I want to still read it so I know what my son believes and why.

On top of all that, I talked to Ian just a little while ago and Ian said that Kunuut's mother called Kunuut last night and told him that she too is getting baptized like Ian to be obedient to Christ and His Word. WOW, WOW, WOW.....God is working.....Yes !!!!! I met Kunuut's mother a few months ago and we talked about the Lord, and the gift of salvation.

Juliana has moved from town for about 6 months. We have called her and she seems to be still struggling a little in her life. She sounds like she is not very happy with her temporary move south. She needs prayer, she needs to surrender to Christ totally.



Our Bible studies will continue until we leave and we will be meeting with Wycliffe Bible Translators while in the USA to talk more about how we can re-translate the Greenlandic Bible into electronic form to be free on the Net for anybody to read or download, more on that later in the next update after the meeting.



We didn't get to take "Qaamaneq" (The Boat) on any local village trips this last month because we couldn't find anybody willing to help us on the boat. The boat is too big for just Solveig and me to handle on a trip like that, although next year we have some potential people that will go. Pray for that.
